This arrangement has already received preliminary approval from the SBA, but the SBA's expense is subject to final vote of the SBA board and approval from the university to expend the SBA's funds in this manner (because this expense was not originally accounted for in the SBA's proposed budget that was approved by the university in spring 2020.
2) Should the SBA board or the university not approve the expenditure, then the grant will cover the sitting/set up charge and the students will purchase their individual files.

We have asked for a quote from the vendor that takes our students' graduation portraits and creates our graduates' composite portrait.
