Through Lucky Red Envelopes for Children, APABA South Florida hopes to bring the traditions and joy of Lunar New Year to economically disadvantaged children in South Florida. Lunar New Year is celebrated globally by more than 1.5 billion people and marks the beginning of the lunar calendar. In many Asian cultures, it is a time for gathering among family and the delivery of "lai see," red envelopes containing lucky money, from older family members to children to herald in a prosperous new year. In this program, APABA will create special "lai see" to educate children about Lunar New Year cultural traditions and to bring good fortune and joy.

APABA will work with an Asian American designer (www.wontoninamillion.com) to create informational and fun kits with child-friendly activities about Lunar New Year traditions. Some traditions we cover could include cleaning before the new year, wearing red, the Chinese zodiac, and eating certain lucky foods. APABA will engage its young lawyer and law student community for help putting the kits together and writing special notes. APABA will coordinate with a local homeless shelter or foster care program to deliver the kits to children in need.
