Description:**

Throughout the year, the Palm Beach County Bar Association Young Lawyer's Section volunteers at Quantum House in their Chef for a Day Program. Quantum House is a hospitality house where out-of-town families whose children are receiving medical treatment for a serious medical condition can stay during treatment. Every day, Quantum House tries to serve three meals for the families staying at the House so the families do not have to think about planning and preparing their own meals after a long day. Because this is a daily routine, the House relies on volunteer organizations to alleviate the burden of providing food and cooking for the families through their Chef for a Day Program. Chef for A Day volunteers are asked to plan, purchase, and prepare the meal for the House families, which is usually about 60-70 guests. The House also encourages groups to bring crafts, games, etc. to lift the spirits of the families. During COVID, our YLS has been unable to cook the Chef for a Day meals within the house and interact with the families, but we still volunteered in the Program by simply dropping off pre-made meals for the House families, along with an activity for them to enjoy. Our YLS would like to continue providing this critical volunteer service to Quantum House, which is why we decided to include it in this grant application!
