Description:**

The Young Lawyers Section of the South Palm Beach County Bar Association has developed a longstanding relationship with Pine Grove Elementary School in Delray Beach, Florida. Pine Grove

Elementary is a Title I school with a large percentage of children from low-income families. Throughout the year, we plan the following series of events to benefit the children of Pine Grove:

1. August – School Supply Drive.

- a. Local firms act as collection points for school supplies to benefit the children of Pine Grove Elementary
- b. The YLS hosts a happy hour where a portion of the proceeds are donated to the school, and attendees are required to donate at least 1 school supply item to gain entry to the event
- c. The YLS Board meets with school administrators to drop off the supplies before school starts for the year.

2. November – Thanksgiving Food Drive

- a. Local firms act as collection points for non-perishable food items and gift cards to local grocery stores to benefit the children and families of Pine Grove Elementary
- b. The YLS Board meets with school administrators to drop off the donations prior to the Thanksgiving Holiday.

3. December – Holiday Book/Toy Drive

- a. The South Palm Beach County Bar Association has a holiday party each December. In previous years, the YLS board asked attendees to donate an elementary age appropriate book/toy which were donated to Pine Grove Elementary school's students. In 2019 the YLS board donated bicycles and helmets for the children as well.

4. May – Law Day

- a. Each May, the YLS board organizes a “Law Day” at Pine Grove Elementary where local attorneys speak to the students about the law and answer any questions they may have

	about the law or becoming a lawyer. Law Day is a national day to celebrate the rule of law. It focuses on how the law and legal process contributes to freedoms and the role of courts. This event was part of an ongoing commitment by the Young Lawyers Section to promote community outreach within the organization. b. The YLS board plans to continue this tradition in Spring 2021 and again in Spring 2022.
