Description/Agenda (Please include a brief description/agenda for your event)

The event concept created by the Broward County Hispanic Bar Association is a Statewide Zoom town-hall style "Minority Women Community Leaders" Event (the "Event"). The invited panelists would answer pre-screened questions talking about how they came into their positions of community service, the challenges they faced along the way, advice to young people about how they can get involved, and the importance of the same.

The Event will feature a 4-5 person panel consisting of Judges, Professionals, Businesswomen, other Female Public Servants of diverse minority backgrounds. In addition to the question and answer session with the panel, we will provide tangible resources (through documents, and links) which the attendees can utilize to help them become more involved in their communities.

By working with other voluntary bar associations throughout the State, the Broward County Hispanic Bar Association has hosted events of this scale over the past year (with live Zoom attendance averaging 140 persons). For the Event we will work with many voluntary bar associations throughout the state which we have partnered with over the past year (likely 5-10 different voluntary bar associations will partner for this Event). Typically, for a Zoom event of this scale there would be a \$10 charge per individual attending the event. If we are fortunate enough to secure the Florida Bar Young Lawyers Division 2020 Inclusion & Equality Grant, the Grant funds will be used as a scholarship to fully cover the cost of attendance of the Event to ensure that attendees incur no cost, and that the message of our organization and our partner voluntary bar associations reaches as many people as possible.
