As lawyers, we all are guilty of focusing too much on work, and not enough on making a difference in our community in our free time. Our organization is in the process of preparing for its 3rd annual Hungry No More event to solve this problem of our lawyers not taking enough time to appreciate the resources we have as lawyers to help our community by serving those less fortunate.

This event largely focused around Thanksgiving, whereby we work with a local food kitchen, Children's Outreach, out of Riveria Beach, Florida. Through our various connections in the area, we have been able to purchase food at cost from Cheney Brother's Distribution company (a local food distribution company). The past two years our members were responsible for planning, raising monies for, purchasing, picking up and transporting turkeys, sides, and drinks to feed hundreds of people in the area.

On "D day", our members meet at Cheney Distribution to pick up multiple pallets worth of food and drinks and load our vehicles with the items. We then transport the items to the food kitchen across town and unload the items with the help of volunteers from the food kitchen.

On Thanksgiving morning, some of our members then help prepare and distribute the free meals to members of the community along with the food kitchen, so they can have a warm meal for Thanksgiving. The goal is to allow our members not only a healthy opportunity to volunteer their time physically, but also to allow our lawyers an opportunity to give back to the community, helping our lawyers learn the value of giving back to those less fortunate in our area. Kindness and a new perspective on what giving back can do, are all huge components of this event, along with the challenge to raise money and if wanted, help

pick up and distribute.

Collectively, the past two years, we have raised close to \$10,000 and been responsible, along with Children's Outreach, for feeding 1000s of people on Thanksgiving Day! For Thanksgiving day this year, our goal is \$7500 worth of donations and to feed 600 people. Further, into 2021 our goal is to expand the Hungry No More event to include another day of giving, Hungry and Needing No More 2.0, potentially in mid 2021, in which our members give back by raising funds to have a second food drive. Whereby meals are given to members in our community working with another food kitchen in another area of the county. In 2021, we are also planning to potentially collect non-perishable goods like clothes, shoes, and other necessities to provide on this Hungry and Needing No More 2.0 day.

All of our board members will be responsible for raising donations, helping pick up and drop off, and potentially handing out the goods for our event. Our "Challenge" will be to expand our event, and increase donations to two full events. We will also have each individual members keep track of donations procured, and award the member who gets the most donations in terms of monetary amount as the "Top Prize".
