Our headshot event fits the parameter of the Professionalism Grant because first impressions are crucial during the interview process. Employers look at a students' Linked-In and look at their social-media presence to understand the candidates. We want our students to be equipped with all the tools necessary to help them stand out professionally. Many students cannot afford headshots or take the time to arrange one. Because we can photograph many students on the same day, this dramatically

cuts down the per-student cost of the headshots.
