Event Description	Young Lawyers Section of the Broward County Bar Association has started a new program called a "YLS Lunch with Judiciary" where we have a small gathering of 8-10 lawyers at lunch time with different Judges. We are holding these events at the courthouse in the Judge's chambers. Each lunch is with a different Judge. These lunches are either a "brown bag" lunch, or ideally we are having a law firm sponsor each lunch for anywhere between \$50-150 depending on the number of people who attend. We are having these lunches every month and plan on continuing these lunches through the end of the year. At these lunches it's a very informal conversation with the Judge. We encourage open questions about life as a lawyer, advice, professionalism and ethical questions, and any other topics people bring to the table. We've found that this intimate setting allows young lawyers to feel more comfortable with the Judges they are practicing in front of and not be as intimidated. Also, we try to choose Judges from many different areas to encourage new lawyers to attend, so we have criminal, civil, family, county, circuit etc. to make sure all of our members are being served.
