Event Description	Since 2008, YLS has hosted an annual event for summer clerks and new associates providing an introduction to the Jacksonville legal community. The Noon in June program features presentations from Duval County Court and United States District Court and Magistrate Judges, the State Attorney and Public Defender's Offices and Jacksonville Area Legal Aid representatives as well as tours of the various judicial and government buildings. The event culminates in a social held prior to the YLS annual meeting affording the opportunity to meet YLS members and Board of Governor candidates. This Committee will work closely with the Annual Committee in selecting a date.

Will any monies received from the YLD be used to purchase alcohol, travel expenses, or attorney house?	No
How will the YLD funds be utilized?	We are lucky that the Jacksonville community supports our event. We typically reserve the jury room in the federal court house for no cost which is where we will start the program. We will work our way through a walking tour of the federal courthouse, SAO historical court room, the Jacksonville Area Legal Aid offices, which will culminate into a separate annual meeting event. At the beginning of Noon in June (which starts at noon), we provide lunch for young lawyers and clerks, which can get costly when we are feeding 75-100 people. Thus, the funds will go to the cost of lunch. Please also see the attached budget.

How does your event fit into the parameters of the Grant?	We incorporate tours of the federal courthouse where federal and state judges present to the group. These presentations include discussions on professionalism in writing and conduct from the perspective of the judges.
Will your event benefit any other groups?	Yes, the event will incorporate presentations from the State Attorneys Office, Public Defenders, Federal and State Judiciary, and local legal aid to showcase the work of phenomenal 4th circuit lawyers.
