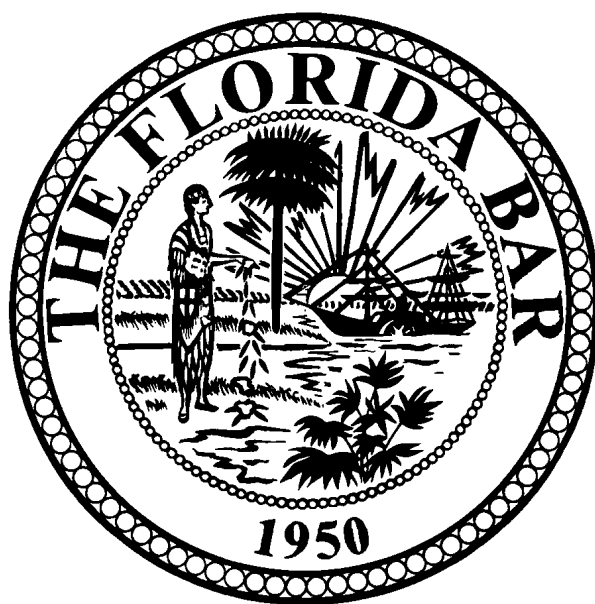

6.22 BASIC SKILLS COURSE

(a) Practicing with Professionalism Course. The Practicing with Professionalism Course required by Rule 6-12.2 must include at least 1 course on The Florida Bar's discipline system.

(b) Elective, Basic, Substantive Continuing Legal Education Courses.

(1) *Continuous Availability.* All elective, basic, substantive legal education courses for BSCR compliance must be available continuously.

(2) *Comprehensive Practice Areas.* The elective, basic, substantive legal education courses must include a full menu of compliant phase 2 courses, including:

- (A) appellate practice;
- (B) bankruptcy;
- (C) business litigation;
- (D) criminal law;
- (E) discovery;
- (F) evidence;
- (G) family law;
- (H) labor & employment law;
- (I) probate and estate planning;
- (J) personal injury;
- (K) real estate;
- (L) transactional law; and
- (M) trial practice.
